Spread the Word *Alumni and Student Referral Program*

Terms and Conditions

The Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions Spread the Word program is open to all current students and alumni of Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions (RMU).

Current students and alumni may participate by completing the referral form, which includes providing the name and contact information of prospective students who may be interested in enrolling at RMU. The referral form must be completed in its entirety. If a current student is the referrer, the current student must have already started the program at RMU. The Referrer may refer as many prospective students as he or she desires. RMU will mail one small gift per referral, regardless of whether the person being referred enrolls in RMU, to the Referrer using the mailing address provided on the referral form. The gift to the Referrer will not exceed a monetary value of \$25 and is not redeemable for cash.

Prospective Students who are referred by a current student or alumni are eligible to receive the \$500 Spread the Word tuition reduction subject to meeting all enrollment criteria. Being referred does not guarantee admission into any program. To receive the award, the Prospective Student must meet all application requirements, apply, be accepted, and enroll. Once the Prospective Student has enrolled and the referral form has been received, a \$500 tuition reduction will be added to the Prospective Student's financial ledger. The \$500 tuition reduction can only be applied to the first semester of the program. Referral forms received after the start of the program (the first day of class) are ineligible to receive the benefits of this program.

Students who are employees, faculty, staff, or alumni of Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions are not eligible to be recipients of the tuition reduction.

By completion of a referral form, Referrer agrees to these Terms and Conditions. RMU may terminate the program at any time without notice. RMU is not responsible for technical problems or submission errors. RMU reserves the right to disqualify any participant if, in its sole discretion, a participant has not complied with the Terms and Conditions or has otherwise attempted to disrupt the program. Participant releases RMU from all liability arising out of participation in the program.
