

Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions (RMUoHP) acknowledges it signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement on April 15, 2020, and gives the assurance that RMUoHP will use 100% of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

- 1. The first half of funds RMUoHP received on May 20, 2020, from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution to students is \$111,638. These funds were sent to awardees on May 22, 2020.
- 2. The second half of funds RMUoHP received on July 22, 2020, from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution to students is \$111,638. These funds were sent to awardees on November 20, 2020.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of December 15, 2020 is \$223,267.00.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at RMUoHP eligible to participate in programs under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act is about 1,591.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an award from the CARES Act Grant under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 342.
- 6. The instructions, directions, or guidance provided by RMUoHP to all students concerning the Student Relief Fund (including CARES Act grant) were sent via University email and published on the University website. Please see CARES Act FAQ.
- 7. The methods used to determine which and students receive CARES Act grant funds are as follows:
 - Enrolled in at least 3 credit hours during 2020
 - Eligible for funding under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965
 - Completed 2019-2020 and/or 2020-2021 FAFSA



Summer awards were assessed based on information given in the application. Examples of award equations are below:
